

# Project Graduation 2008 Information



**Location:** Westwood High School  
**Date:** May 31, 2008, 11pm to June 1, 2008, 5:30am  
**Bring:** A current Westwood Student ID  
Or valid driver's license

*1<sup>st</sup> early registration deadline Eligible for \$100 gift card: April 30, 2008*

*2<sup>nd</sup> early registration deadline eligible for \$50 gift card: May 14, 2008*

Project Graduation 2008 is sponsored by parents of graduating students at Westwood High School and is not a function of the Round Rock Independent School District or Westwood High School. The event is intended to promote a drug and alcohol free environment to be enjoyed by the 2008 graduating class of Westwood High School. Activities will begin at 11 pm on May 31, 2008 and will conclude at approximately 5:30 am on Sunday, June 1, 2008. Students may start to be released as early as 5:00 am if activities have been concluded. A current Westwood ID or valid driver's license is required at check-in.

Once students have entered the building, they will not be allowed to leave and re-enter. Students who leave the event must sign out, and will not be allowed back into Project Graduation. Parents/Guardians will be called at the time the student signs out to let them know that their child has left the event early. Early would be defined as any time prior to 5:00 am on June 1, 2008. The student will then be escorted to their car by a Project Graduation volunteer. Students who leave the event early will not be eligible for prize drawings.

To participate in Project Graduation, the enclosed Student Participation Form must be completed and signed by a parent/guardian and returned to the senior office beginning April 14, 2008. Please be sure to *sign the form and provide a phone number* where a parent/guardian can be reached during Project Graduation 2008. Participants who register by **Wednesday, April 30 will be eligible for a \$100 gift card** and those who register by **Wednesday, May 14 will be eligible for a \$50 gift card**. Drawing will be held the day of graduation practice but winners must attend the entire Project Graduation event to claim their early registration prize. Every student in attendance will receive chances to win various prizes during Project Graduation. These prizes will be awarded by random drawings and the students must attend the entire event to be eligible.
